Hop vine refuse and silage may be fed to livestock. For suckering and stripping: spray only the basal 2 ft. of the vines. Repeat as necessary. The response of hops to GRAMOXONE MAX differs by variety. High alpha variety hops tend to require higher rates of GRAMOXONE MAX for suckering and stripping. Test the use rate selected on a small number of vines of each variety to be treated to determine sensitivity to injury. Do not use GRAMOXONE MAX on varieties, which show unacceptable injury. Chemical Pruning: To burn back existing vines and obtain even emergence of subsequent vines, spray when vines are less than 3 ft. tall. APPLICATION TO HOP VINES LESS THAN 6 FT. TALL MAY CAUSE UNACCEPTABLE INJURY.

Note to Applicators:

- When spraying end-use dilution outside of an enclosed cab or when contacting vegetation wet with spray, wear protective clothing (disposable suit/coveralls or long-sleeved shirt or pants), a wide-brimmed hat and waterproof footwear.
- REMOVE contaminated clothing and wash separate from other laundry with soap and hot water

CHEMIGATION: Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.
