RECOMMENDATIONS

Wiper Applications: All applicable restrictions, precautions and directions in the Honcho Plus label, EPA Reg. No. 524-454, must be followed for this product to be used for weed control in sugar beet production, including the “SELECTIVE EQUIPMENT” section under “WIPER APPLICATORS.”

This SLN may only be used for wiper applications to sugar beets. Contact of the herbicide solution with desirable vegetation may result in crop damage or destruction. Application equipment should be adjusted so that the wiper contact point is at least two (2) inches above the desirable vegetation.

The maximum allowable combined total application per year is 1.2 gallons (3.6 lbs a.i.) of this product per acre.

Rate: Mix 1 gallon of this product in 2 gallons of water to prepare a 33 percent solution.

Weeds should be a minimum of six (6) inches above the desirable vegetation. Better results may be obtained when more of the weed is exposed to the herbicide solution. Weeds not contacted by the herbicide solution will not be affected. This may occur in dense clumps, severe infestations, or when height of weeds varies so that not all weeds are contacted. Applications may be made no later than August 10th of the year used.

Allow at least 30 days between application and harvest.

Grower assumes all responsibility for crop losses from application.
