DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Persons using this product must comply with all applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions found on this labeling and that of the label of the federally registered product upon which this amendment is based.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

- **CATEGORY OF APPLICATOR:** Pre-Plant Soil Fumigation
- **CROP/SITE:** Non-food and non-feed crops—Statewide
- **TARGET PEST:** Potato Cyst Nematode (*Globodera pallida*)
- **DOSAGE/APPLICATION RATE:** 350 to 435 lbs. per acre
- **PRETREATMENT SOIL PREPARATION:** Same as federal label except for minimum temperature: Do not fumigate if the soil temperature is below 42 degrees F at the point of injection.
- **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:**
 - Inject MBC Concentrate with a chisel or noble plow type applicator, having the injection points spaced no more than 12 inches apart and injecting to a minimum depth of 8 to 10 inches below the soil surface.
 - When injecting 10 to 12 inches below the soil surface, injection points must not be more than 24 inches apart.
 - When injecting deeper than 12 inches below the soil surface, injection points must not be more than 36 inches apart.
 - All applications must be sealed immediately with a high barrier polyethylene film.
- **FREQUENCY/TIMING OF APPLICATION:** Applications are to be limited to twice per year for any given treatment area.
- **EXPOSURE:** 24 to 48 hours
- **TARP REMOVAL:** The HBPE film can be removed 48 hours after application.
